AMC Updates – Annalee Garletz

- Invasive species bill, proposed by tax chair
 - o Targetted money for county program aid
 - Says it needs to be used to prevent and slow the spread of aquatic invasive species
 - o Looked for factor to base money, and tied it to paved boat launch
 - Wanted to make the money as available as possible.
- Recorder bill, lot split bill, goes to tax committee because it is tax code.

- Rulemaking bill changed significantly, new language under House version, # of signatures to request a contested hearing was changed to 50, other groups would like to bring it back to 25.
 Will have to list why it goes to contested case hearing. Have each commissioner sign.
 - o SONAR language, PCA wanted to delete all questions understatement of need and reasonableness, we have shortened it and condensed some questions into one.
- Number of agency streamlining bills. Giving PCA Administrative Penalty Order (APO) for septic violations
- Wetland conservation act. BWSR have summer meetings.
 - Senator Scoe introduced a bill that combined the NE Wetland Mitigation Plan and other streamlining pieces that senators were looking for.
 - o AMC supportive of more flexibility for more public value.
 - May be one MACPZA one AMC sort of thing
- NACO-draft
 - o Waters of the US rulemaking
 - EPA seemed dismissive of drainage concerns
 - Its all good and well and doesn't think that it doesn't impact
 - Waters of the US is used in other rules and laws, and have unintended impacts
 - Going to be a congressional hearing.
 - Think about who might be interested from districts to look at this and figure out how it would impact your county.
 - Are MN Rules more restrictive already?
