Legistlative Update:

- 2016 Session started on March 8, 2016, late start due to the State Capitol renovations.
- Highlights- Bonding Bill, Tax Bill and Transportation Bill
- Lot Split Bill- still alive
- Grannie Pod Bill, Bill 2497, should go to the floor in the house, will be dead if not heard this week, MACPZA concerns:
 - Self contained units, septic issues
 - Permit fees
 - Building code
 - · Require deposit in escrow in order to remove from properties
 - DNR-Shoreland issues
 - Water
 - Protect the public health, safety and welfare.
 - MACPZA remains neutral due to the option of a resolution by the County Board to not allow them.
- Group will meet with avocates on April 4, 2016.
- Cities and Townships have a softer stance on the bill, Counties stand alone in holding up the bill,
- County Board Resolution to opt out of the bill.

MSP:Terry/Angie MACPZA is remains neutral as long as the following are adhered to:

- Clause remains in place that allows the County Board to pass a resolution to Opt Out;
- Allowed Use (County to decide whether permitted or Conditional Use)
- Collect permit fees;
- Meet building code standards;
- Protect the health, safety and welfare.
