2) Local Program Grants County Funding - \$55,600 with match required 6 Applications (5 Lakes) - \$34,135 requested

3) Inspections and Decontamination Inspections – Partnership (County, Watershed, DNR) Decons – Partnership (Lake Assc, City, County, DNR) Additional Tools – Sentry Units, Car Counters, Decon Hotline
