


Increase in Renewables


Renewables by Type


Growth of Solar

Siting Process for Solar Facilities > 50 MW

- Application
- Environmental Review with Scoping
- Public Hearing
- Commission Decision
- Permit Issuance
- Compliance through construction and permit life

Permit Conditions

- 30-year permit
- Complaint procedures
- Establishment of beneficial habitat
- Decommissioning requirement

Decommissioning Plans

Decommissioning plans describe

- How the physical components will be removed
- How site will be restored
- The estimated cost of decommissioning
- How funds will be available at the end of the facility's life to accomplish decommissioning tasks

Working Group Recommendations

Decommissioning plans should be

- Required
- Detailed
- Adaptable

Working Group Recommendations

Financial Assurance

- Provide a variety of financial instruments be available to project owners
- Financial surety is not necessary at the outset, but should be in place prior to decommissioning
- Financial sureties can be implemented incrementally, possibly beginning about year 10
- State or local governmental entities should be the beneficiary, not individual landowners

Department Recommendations – Plan Content

- Project Description
- Decommissioning Objective
- Permits and Notifications
- Tasks and Timing
- Estimated Cost
- Financial Assurance

Department Recommendations – Plan Review

- Draft decommissioning plan with permit application
- Pre-construction plan
- 5-year rolling review
- Update at project milestones
- Refer to Commission as project ages
