- Conference

 - Build on Kenny's presentation drill down into what some of those implications may be
 - Messages on how local government policies/decisions could offset impacts
 - 2 part presentation-then discussion on impacts and then feedback on how do we message it especially so elected officials hear.
 - Hard to justify climate change, when we had a drought and we yo-yo not sure how we say we are out of wack with floodplain.
 - Polling/discussion
- The latest bluff guidance
 - o Shared shoreland regulations website and bluff resources
 - Quick guide to analyzing slopes with MnTopo
 - Detailed technical guidance document on how to identify bluffs using the definition
- Floodplain model ordinance
 - o 45 minute training video goes through model ordinance
 - Supplemental application form
 - o Unless map changes hold off on adopting it uncompelled, additional clean-up
- New training videos
- Efforts with MAT on township guidance
 - Handful of counties that engaged
 - Continued challenges with what is DNR role, a lot of gray area. Working with attorney's to work on guidance or standard operating procedures.

- FEMA started asking questions, Federal requires autonomous communities to enroll in the program.
- 65 townships in the state-14 enrolled in program, 3 have been sanctioned by FEMA
- Only 26 counties in the state have at least one township with zoning authority
- Statutorily required to review and approve all floodplain ordinances as well as monitor floodplain permitting activities
- DNR does not have express approval authority for shoreland ordinances for townships
- Looking to define better, come up with concrete guidance get feedback from MACPZA
- Substantial damage playbook
 - Guidebook for helping with substantial damage
